Abstract

Having conducted a comparative review of China and Africa's distinct development paths and current policy contexts, the authors discuss China's development lessons for Africa South of the Sahara and policy recommendations for China-Africa engagement related to agricultural and rural development, openness and liberalization, evidence-based policymaking, pro-poor policies, institutions and capacity, rising inequality, and environmental degradation.

Abstract:

This research tracked the implementation of the SAATDC bilateral agreement to examine whether this bilateral agreement was effectively implemented or not. There is a need to translate political commitment into a practical programme for successful implementation.

Abstract

Recently there has been a growing interest in China's rapid economic growth, particularly concerning the role of agriculture and its impact on poverty reduction. While China and Africa have developed their agricultural sectors under different historical conditions, this article proposes that China's poverty reduction and smallholder-based agricultural policies can provide a useful model for African countries to develop their own strategies in agrarian change.

Abstract:

What role does China play in the recent rush for land acquisition in Africa? Conventional wisdom suggests a large role for the Chinese government and its firms. Our research suggests the opposite. Land acquisitions by Chinese companies have so far been quite limited, and focused on production for African consumption. We trace the evolution of strategy and incentives for Chinese agricultural engagement in Africa, and examine more closely several of the more well known cases, sorting out the myths and the realities.

摘要:

中国“十二五”规划纲要明确提出：“走出去”的企业和境外合作项目，要履行社会责任，造福当地人民。本论文

通过中国对老挝农业投资企业履行社会责任状况的调查，发现中国对外企业在带动增收、带动就业、民生改善、社区发展、慈善公益等方面取得了显著的成绩。然而，部分企业在履行社会责任方面表现不佳，有待改进。未来，应进一步加强投资国、东道国、新闻媒体、社会团体以及境外投资企业自身等利益相关者的合作努力，从而共同推动中国对外农业投资企业积极承担社会责任。

摘要：

大陆顶替台湾在非洲农耕队援助计划是探讨冷战时期中国对非援助模式与成效的典型案例。大陆农技专家通过施行自办公助策略、建立具有社会主义潜质的合作社、施行农业“八字宪法”、传播“大寨精神”等措施，力图在非洲建立与大寨高度类似的农业生产模式，使非洲国家的农业生产真正自力更生，进而证明中国自身发展道路的优越性。但这种农业生产模式与非洲国家的自然和社会条件冲突，顶替援助未能实现最终目标。今天对非农业援助正在成为中国对非经济合作的重点，并且实行投资与援助相结合、以互利为目的的经济合作模式，但顶替援助这段特殊的历史过程仍有许多值得品味和总结的经验教训。

摘要：

本文通过回顾20世纪60—70年代至今的各种农业援助形式的表现，尤其是对当前正在开展的中国在非洲的农业技术示范中心进行案例研究，反思中国援助项目在非洲无法实现预期目标和难以持久的原因，并探寻进一步改善援助效果的方法。作者认为，对非洲援助形式的演变与中国自身的市场改革过程密切相关，援助项目逐步市场化运作体现了中国的发展经验，但非洲农村的独特环境对实施项目的中方企业提出挑战，援助者需要在具体实践中仔细摸索可行路径。同时，中国农业援非的探索过程也反映了国际发展援助的普遍困境，在推动落后地区经济发展时，外来援助往往无法融入当地社会，达成本质内生的转变。问题的解决要求援助者转变思路，不以外加标准来衡量援助效果，而应将援助视为协助当地社会向现代化转变的助推器和润滑剂，并从受援国长期整体的发展以及全球经济一体化的角度出发对援助作用进行全面评价。
